



Eligibility and requirements

- Member of Bayside Student Ministry
- Regular Attendee for Sunday Worship: 9:30 AM
- Regular Attendee for Sunday Youth Bible Study: 11:00 AM
- Regular Attendee for Wednesday Bible Study: 6:00 PM – 7:30 PM
- Demonstrates a Christ-like attitude and respect for all people. (Matthew 5:16; 1 Corinthians 10:31; Romans 12:1-2; John 13:34, James 1:22-26; Mark 12:30-31)
- Demonstrates our Church mission to: Love God – Love People
- Participates in Youth Mission/Service Projects. Examples include:
 - Food Pantry, Sunday Youth SERVE days, Widow/Widower Ministry: Clean yards, etc., See You at the Pole, Church Clean up and projects, Honor Guard Recognition, See You at the Pole, Trunk/Treat Outreach Night, Thanksgiving SERVE for Food Pantry, Angel Tree Shopping Trip for those in need, Fellowship Meal preparation, etc.
- Participates on a church ministry team. Examples include:
 - Hospitality, Media, Worship, Sign Language, Properties, 12Nine Disabilities, Kids Church, Worship Choir, Properties, etc.
- Participates and supports youth events and outings. Examples include:
 - Youth nights, movie night, Church Picnic/Softball, Youth FUSION, Fall Festival, Christmas Caroling, etc.
- Is a Christ follower or actively seeking Christ. (Jeremiah 29:13)
- Can share testimony and steps being taken for personal spiritual growth. (IE: Regular bible study time, regular prayer time, mission/service projects, scripture memorization, etc.)
- Has completed a Travel Team Application.
